District Continues to Cut Costs and Control Expenses

Forest Hill Public Utility District, California \$2,081,149 Series 2014 Water Revenue Refunding Loan (2003 Water System Improvement Refunding Project)

> VERIFICATION REPORT August 8, 2014

In August of 2014 the District refinanced the Sugar Pine Dam Debt. The interest that the district will save over the 20 years totaled \$586,994.76. Ten years have passed since the refinancing, and it has remained a significant source of savings for the district, the lower interest costs and a shorter loan term.



Enabling AutoPay will authorize the total balance on the account to draft on the 15th of every month taking away all the bill-paying woes.
