- 1. Overview of the Proposition 218 Protest Hearing Process President Cochran provided an overview of the Proposition 218 Protest Hearing Process.
- Open the Proposition 218 Hearing: Proposed Water Rate Increases to Commence on March 15, 2020 (Fiscal Year 2019-2020) and on or about each January 15 thereafter through Fiscal Year 2023-24. President Cochran opened the public hearing at 7:07 PM
- 3. <u>Presentation:</u> District Staff will present a brief overview of the District's compliance with Proposition 218 procedural requirements. *President Cochran dispensed with the presentation.*
- 4. <u>Presentation:</u> HF&H Consultants will present a summary of the cost of service study's findings which support the proposed rate increase, including the amount of the increase, the basis upon which the rates have been calculated, and how the collected rates will be expended. *President Cochran dispensed with the presentation*.
- 5. **Open Public Comment:** This is the time for any member of the public to address the Board of Directors on any matter on the agenda. Directors and staff are limited by law to brief responses and clarifying questions to comments. Comments shall be limited to three minutes per person, or such other time limit as may be imposed by the President. As a

courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones and any other distracting devices. All speakers must address the board from the podium with the microphone. Please be respectful to the person speaking from the podium. *Public comment was received*

- 6. Close the public hearing: All protests must be submitted prior to the close of the public comment. President Cochran closed the public hearing at 7:25 PM
- 7. Consideration and Tabulation of the Protests: General Manager Henry White reported the number of protests necessary to receive 50% + 1 of owners and customers of record was 1,018 protests. General Manager White reported staff validated 1,108 protests representing a majority protest.
